## Hawkesbury & District General Hospital Mental Health and Addictions Regional Centre

JLR was retained by Hawkesbury General Hospital to design a new \$7M purpose-built facility for the relocation of its regional community mental health and addictions program. The new 30,000 ft<sup>2</sup> facility houses offices and purpose-built spaces designed for the provision of services in addiction, crisis, geriatric-psychiatry, mental health, and assertive treatments.

## Maplewoods Centre for Family Therapy and Child Psychology

JLR was retained to provide multidisciplinary engineering and architectural services to renovate the existing lab building into a state-of-the-art treatment and education facility. The design began with an intensive stakeholder engagement process represented by staff and client groups to create an inclusive space to support diverse needs. Through consultation, we were able to create a design that was bright, colourful, and welcoming for both patients and clinicians. The project included the full renovation of 32,400 ft<sup>2</sup> of interior space as well as the renewal of all mechanical and electrical building systems.

## Cardiac Centre of Excellence

JLR was retained by Health Sciences North to provide consulting services for a 15,000 ft<sup>2</sup> renovation to the existing Sudbury Out-Patient Care Facility. As a specialized medical facility, consultation with multiple stakeholder groups was crucial during the design phase of this project. The floorplan was divided into clinic spaces and pods for each of the doctors using the facility. The private pods incorporate an office, patient room, and reception area for each doctor. The administration section of the facility is located at the opposite end of the building to keep staff and patients separate.
